The Companies Compared

- A price comparison between:
 - DX Engineering – DXE
 - Ham Radio Outlet – HRO
 - Amateur Radio Supplies – ARS

The Products Compared

- 200 feet of HD rotor cable; 8 Conductor, 2 x 16 AWG, 6 x18 AWG, Stranded CU, PVC Jacket, Rotor Wire.
- LMR600 Coax

Results of 200' of HD rotor cable

- DX Engineering sold it for \$1.21 per foot or \$242.00 plus freight and maybe sales tax.
- HRO sold it for \$1.19 per foot for \$238.00, free shipping.
- ARS sold it for \$146.99, free shipping and no sales tax.
 - That was 73.5 cents per foot, 37.9% less for equivalent heavy-duty rotor cable.

Results of 200' of LMR600 coax

- HRO sells LMR600 for \$479.95 for 200 feet.
- ARS sells the same coax for \$191.95 for 100 feet, or \$383.90 without calling for a unit price.
- DXE doesn't quote LMR600 on their website.

Conclusion

- Bob discovered Amateur Radio Supply by accident and has found that they have extraordinary prices on wire and cable products.
- Save money where you can. Do some research before purchasing products, especially the high-end products. You might just find a few extra bucks in your wallet.
